History Committee

The History of the Section for the first 75 years was completed and printed in hardback and paperback versions in the 1990s. Some paperback copies are still available from Jim Beck. The plan for the completed version for the first 100 years includes publication on the Section website.

Jim Beck and Larry White have worked on the additional chapters for 1991-2015 and with the assistance of Ann Sullivan, have them on the website ready for proof reading for grammatical and informational content. An appendix has been included on the web site which includes Section Chairs, Distinguished Service Award winners and winners of the High School, Middle School, and Elementary School teaching awards, Industry Award winners, Senior Chemistry Major Award winners, and top finishers in the International Chemistry Olympiad exams, and other awards and winners of the Section that are available, and numerous documents and copies of posters, as well as information on the 100 Anniversary celebration.

After the end of each year, the history for that year will be added to the website. Early this year, 2016 will be added. The past year (2017) will be added in the early spring. We have acquired some other sources of information, including *Bulletins* not currently in our possession, other Section documents, and contact information on ACS national offices that may have information about the Section. We plan to use these sources and "rewrite the History" to incorporate pertinent information into the website account to the History of the *Virginia Section of the American Chemical Society*.
